**SCHEDULE FOR SWIMMING TEST FOR FIREMAN & TOPASS -
RECRUITMENT TO THE POSTS OF BOAT CREW STAFF**

NOTIFICATION 12/2025-BCS

1. Refer to Notification of 01/2025-BCS published in the Employment News dated 08-14 Mar 25. You are hereby intimated that you are provisionally eligible for appearing in the swimming test for the post of Fireman.

2. Candidates who have appeared for written examination on 30 Nov 25 are directed to report at TIFR Gate, Navy Nagar, Colaba, Mumbai-400 005 on 16 Feb 2026 at 0830 hrs for swimming test. Towards this, e-mails have been forwarded to all candidates in end Jan 26.

3. **Swimming Test.** The swimming test shall be conducted as per the criteria mentioned below:-

'50 meter swimming followed by 2.30 minutes of floating (without any floating aids) and 05 meters jump'

4. **Documents to be carried.** You are requested to carry the following documents for verification:-

4.1 Copy of email received from Naval Dockyard, Mumbai.

4.2 Copy of Admit Card issued for Written Examination.

4.3 02 latest Passport size colour photograph with plain white background without any obstacle covering/ obstructing the face and eyes. The photograph should not be more than three months old and should have full face coverage. The size of photo document should be between 3.5cms X 4.5cms.

4.4 Proof of Date of Birth. Birth Certificate/ Matriculation or 10th Board Certificate.

4.5 Proof of Name. Matriculation certificate issued by Central Board/ State/ Other board. If you have changed your name after matriculation, please bring along a copy of Gazette Notification.

4.6 Proof of Identity. Passport/ Aadhaar Card/ Voter ID Card/ Driving License/ Ration card with Photo or any other identity document issued by the Government of India.

5. Advisory for Swimming Test.

5.1 Please carry along a swimming trunk, swimming cap etc. required for giving the test. Also note that you will not be permitted to appear for the swimming test without the

swimming trunk. Swimming is not permitted in shorts. Naval Dockyard, Mumbai shall not be providing any swimming trunks at the pool.

5.2 The swimming test will be undertaken by you at your own risk and an indemnity bond is required to be filled by you at the swimming pool prior to the swimming test.

5.3 Naval Dockyard, Mumbai does not take any responsibility in the event of occurrence of any accident during the swimming test.

6. General Advisory.

6.1 You are required to make your own arrangements for stay during the period of test.

6.2 Please note that calling you for the swimming test does NOT in any way confirm your selection for the post which is purely provisional. Your selection and thereafter appointment for the post would be based on merit in the written examination, qualifying the swimming test, verification of all the documents, correctness of information furnished by you while applying and satisfactory medical examination.
